#### **ASK A LAWYER**

The attorneys at the Dedham law firm of Samuel, Sayward & Baler LLC will answer a question each month related to estate planning or elder law issues such as wills, trusts, probate, estates, Medicaid, or veteran's benefits. Please feel free to submit your questions anonymously by dropping them in the Ask A Lawyer box.

#### This month's question:

Q: My neighbor's husband recently passed away and she told me that her lawyer said that his estate does not need to go to probate. How can this be?

#### **ASK A LAWYER** (from previous column)

A: It is quite possible that no probate is necessary for your friend's husband's estate. A probate proceeding for an estate is only necessary when there are assets in a deceased person's individual name and there is no named beneficiary. For example, a bank account in the decedent's name alone or a life insurance policy with no named beneficiary would need to be probated. Since many married couples hold their real estate and bank accounts jointly, and name each other as the beneficiary of IRAs and life insurance policies, there is often no need for probate when one spouse dies. Of course, this is not always the case. In any event, it is a good idea to consult with an attorney when a spouse dies. Even if there is no probate proceeding required, there may be other tasks which need to be done such as filing an estate tax return and clearing title to real estate. In addition, it is important for the surviving spouse to update his or her estate plan documents.




