- Pension letter
- Checking statement if Social Security or Pension is directly deposied.

- If someone else's name is on a bank account-MUST have proof of their home address
- Self employment must be notarized
- Bank interest over \$100,000
- Renters' lease or letter from landlord including their telephone and address

- Last year's tax return
- Current year's tax forms and booklet.
- Social Security Cards or other official documentation for yourself and all dependants.
- Check book if you want to direct deposit any refunds.
- Unemployment compensation statements.
- SSA-1099 form showing the total Social Security benefits paid to you for the year, or Form RRB-1099, Tier 1 Railroad Retirement benefits.
- 1099 forms reporting interest (1099-INT), dividends (1099-DIV)
