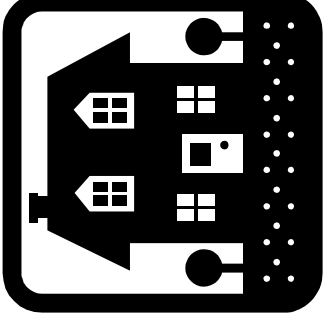


MISSION STATEMENT

REFERRAL PROCESS

Anyone in need of food can contact the Council on Aging at 781-329-8799 and speak to the Director or Outreach Worker. They simply need to provide their name and address. The Westwood Food Pantry has no income guidelines.

HOURS OF OPERATION

The Food Pantry is open daily Monday – Friday from 8:30 A.M. to 2:30 P.M. The monthly distribution takes place on the third Tuesday of each month and on the first Saturday of each month; clients are notified in advance of the day and time.
