Sewer System Pump Station Operator

The Town of Westwood Sewer Department is seeking a Pump Station Operator to perform skilled technical and manual work in the operation, maintenance, and repair of the wastewater system and pump stations.

Duties include but are not limited to the following: Maintenance of records, preventative and emergency repair on all equipment involved in the operation of a sewer system. Monitors and ensures smooth operation of sewage pumping stations and standby equipment; identifies potential problems and breakdowns and takes corrective action; performs related plumbing and pipefitting tasks; performs simple welding; performs basic electrical, carpentry, and painting work as necessary.

Maintains interior and exterior of buildings, and maintains grounds; enters sewer manholes to determine causes of blockages, or for other investigative purposes. Operates blowers, compressors, pumps, electric panels, and other equipment related to the operation of a wastewater pumping station; operates standard office equipment including computers.

Education and Experience: High school education including electro/mechanical engineering, repair, or related field; two years' experience in general mechanical and maintenance activities including operation of pumps; experience in sewer operations or a pumping station preferred; or any equivalent combination of education and experience. Basic computer knowledge required. Massachusetts Class B license required. Ability to obtain a WEF/ABC Class II Wastewater Collection Systems Personnel Certification within one year of employment preferred.

Salary and Benefits: Full-time, union position; 40 hrs/week; \$1,874.45 -- \$2183.41 bi-weekly in eight steps.
