The second objective was to list individuals who entered the armed forces from a different community and subsequently moved to Westwood. This was accomplished. However, the data available would not allow recording by war/conflict. Therefore, you will find an alphabetical list of those who served during the twentieth century.

These honor rolls were completed from the study of various state and local lists of veterans. Each source was invaluable and each one was incomplete. Some data was over sixty years old. This report is the culmination of four years of research.

The final report is the result of the efforts of many townspeople and a number of individuals who reside in other communities.

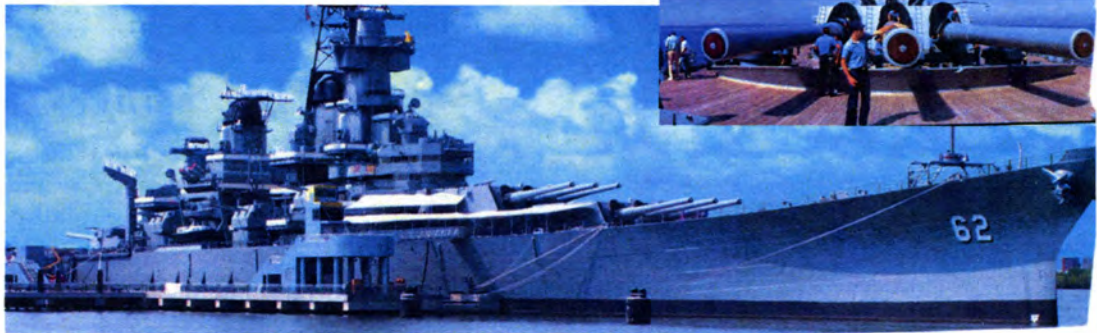
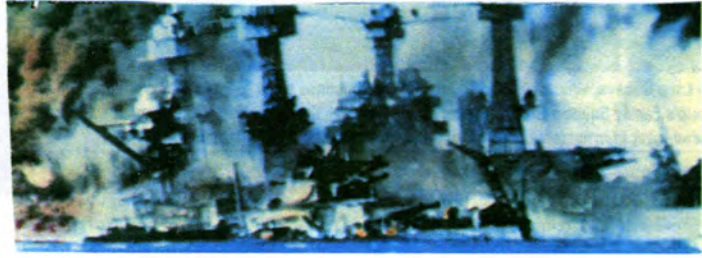

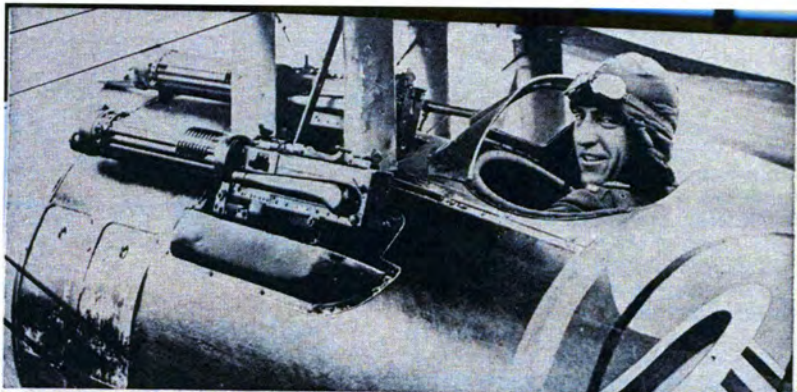
From Copenhagen, however, the information comes that that in the opinion and desire of the Emperor and King of Germany, Austria and Turkey will not remain neutral.

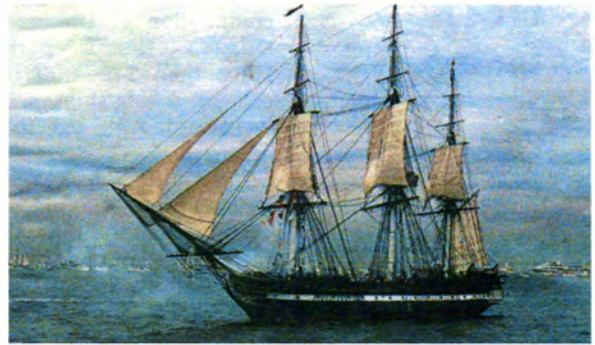
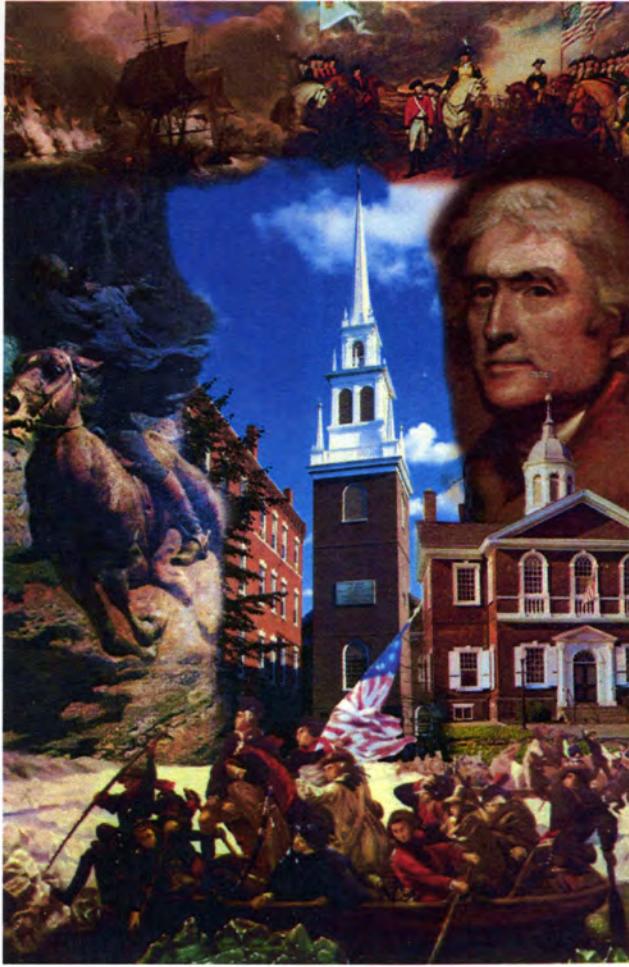
