HOW TO INSTALL A SECOND METER?

LICENSED PLUMBER PROCEDURE

@ BUILDING DEPARTMENT

- Go to the Building Department to apply for 2 permits:
- Application for Second Meter Program (FEE: \$30.00)
- •Plumbing Permit (FEE: \$40.00)

SECOND METER DEVICE DETAILS

- •The Second Meter will be purchased by the homeowner/applicant.
- Meter must be an approved American Water Works displacement type of meter.
- •Minimum size: 5/8" with 3/4" connections.
- Reads in 100 CUBIC FEET.
- A Second Meter only serves plumbing for outdoor water usage (i.e. irrigation system) and/or pool filling.

PROCESS

- •Meter installation must be leak-tight.
- •Meter must be installed in a horizontal position.
- •Meter must be installed **DOWNSTREAM**, **AFTER**, the Dedham-Westwood Water District's Meter.
- •Meter location must be accessible for service and inspection.
- •Meter will be in a location protected from frost and freezing.
- Provide an **upstream and downstream** ball type shutoff valve of high quality with low pressure loss.
