**I. OLD BUSINESS**

**A. TOWN UPDATE**

Beth reported that the Town has been occupied with the following:

1. *Outsource Payroll*

*The Town of Westwood is looking into outsourcing their payroll.*

2. *Web page Updates*

*The town Web page continues to be updated. New information is always solicited.*

3. *Council on Aging*

*Six computers have been setup at the Council on Aging. Town residents can utilize these computers to access the internet.*

4. *Town Bills*

*The cycle of tax, sewer and motor vehicle bills continues, with the responsibility and control at the departmental level.*

5. *Web Base E-Mail*

*Beth Ahern is currently researching the possibilities of having a Web Based E-Mail system. This E-Mail system would allow town employees to access their E-Mail from any computer with Internet Access. The advantage for some users could be home access without additional IS resources.*

6. *ISAB August Meeting*

*There will not be an ISAB meeting for the month of August. The next meeting will be July 11<sup>th</sup> at 7:30pm at Town Hall.*

**B. SCHOOLS UPDATE**

Beth reported the following updates for the School:

1. *Scheduling*

*The majority of the scheduling for students in the High School for the school year 2000-2001 has been completed. Currently the guidance department is adjusting schedules for any students that have conflicts.*

2. *Department of Education*

Kevin Dolan in the I.S. department is currently working on validating and processing 35 more data elements for the state Department of Education.

3. *Starbase Software Demonstration*

*Beth Ahern and John Burton attended a software demonstration on Special Education software that could potentially interface with the Century Starbase system. Three vendors presented a demonstration on a special education plan. The first software package showed the most current development towards the Massachusetts curriculum frameworks and new DOE and IEP requirements. The second package presented uses a pen that*

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*captures student data. This data can then be automatically downloaded from the pen into the database. The third package was a Web based package that teachers could access from their home computers. This package seemed to be the most cost effective (\$10/student) and easy to use. The Quincy, Cambridge, Natick and Brockton school districts also attended this demonstration.*

4. *Bus Routing Software*

*Beth Ahern and Donna McClellan attended a bus routing software demonstration in Chelsea. This package would interface with the Arcview GIS package we are currently using. They will continue to research other alternatives.*

5. *Massachusetts Users Group*

*Kevin Dolan from the I.S. Department attended the monthly Massachusetts Users Group meeting in Quincy.*

1. *GIS Training*

*The GIS department held training classes for beginners, intermediate and advanced users. Beth announced that fifteen departments have been trained in GIS.*

2. *GIS Planning Seminar*

*Beth Ahern and Donna McClellan attended a GIS Planning Seminar in Boxboro.*
