#### I. OLD BUSINESS

#### A. TOWN UPDATE

- 1. The Information Technology operating and capital budgets were approved at Town Meeting. However, because of budget issues, the department positions will be restructured to accommodate a 4 person staff.
- None of the capital budget items for the Police Records Management Software or the Municipal Software were included in the list of capital projects. The end user technology budget which is used each year to support new purchases, replacements, maintenance items was reduced from \$65,000 to \$40,669.

#### B. SCHOOLS UPDATE

- The operating budget for the IT department identified in the school budget has been level funded.
- The capital request to provide a complete web solution for the Student Software was not approved. This money \$24,000 will be taken out of the end user technology budget as well as the School Operating budget.

#### C. CABLE UPDATE

- Westwood was notified by the Department of Telecommunications and Energy that although the waiver of the 60 day solicitation period for advertising was not granted, a 30 day period was allowed.
- 2. Sample Advertisement language for a cable television license was reviewed.
- 3. A summary spreadsheet of revenue received from Comcast since 2001 was provided and reviewed.
