Staffing

Teen Librarian: Teen Librarian position has been re-advertised as a 24-hour benefit eligible position.

Safety/Security Review: Chief Silva provided an overview of safety protocols for library staff at our staff meeting on Thursday, October 25th. A future meeting with Fire Chief John Deckers will be set up after the town has completed safety assessments for all school and municipal buildings.

Town-Wide Steps to Fitness Challenge for Staff: Westwood staff have partnered with the Brigham & Women's Health Center in Westwood for a health challenge initiative. Library Team Name is STORYWALKERS and team includes Claire Connors as Team Captain –with team members Tricia Perry, Andrea Varkas, Joyce Levine, Caroline Tighe, Molly Riportella, and Lizzy McGovern.

Details:

- Team Captain (Claire Connors) collects each team member's steps for the week, tallies the total for the entire team, and submits them to Joan Courtney Murray. Each week runs from Monday through Sunday.
- Each team member will be provided with a free pedometer courtesy of Brigham and Women's Health Care Center Westwood. If you prefer to use your own device, that's fine, too.
- Recognition each week, via email, for the team with the highest average steps per member
- Recognition at the end of the campaign for most total steps by a team and most improved team. Perhaps other records will be set, as well?!
- Competition will run from 10/29 11/30/18
