Islington Branch Library:

Ms. Perry met with Mr. Jaillet on 1/8/18. The current plans for the Islington Redevelopment Project indicate that the library will be moved by the Town of Westwood. The reason is that that work must be done at prevailing wages because it is town property and it is a town building. Projected work on the branch includes a full foundation (basement)and elevator. Building would be ADA-compliant and will include some interior renovations. Planning Board is having a meeting on 1/16/18 at the Downey School to discuss the Islington Redevelopment Project. The order of the project will most likely be: build the new CVS, renovate the old CVS and move MMO into it and then demolish the ICC and build the replica. adult audio books and large print books.

Ms. Persons is looking for the date that the Town of Westwood opened up the first Library for the Birthday Celebration later this year.

Ms. Von Euw had a Friends of the Library Update. Funds are still coming in, historically January is a big month for donations. The Friends also donated books to the Boston Children's Martha Elliot Health Center. Marissa Taranto dropped off the books for the waiting area. The Friends received a great Thank You letter from the Hospital for the donation.
