The library's reclassification and compensation study has been completed with 2 library positions being reclassified and an hourly wage adjustment for substitute librarians and substitute library assistants. Tricia is working with Joan Courtney Murray to determine best options to cover upcoming maternity leave for a staff member.
Islington Center Redevelopment- update:	The Islington Center Task Force (ICTF) continued to review and discuss six proposed options provided by the developer. Task Force members will be asked to vote for an option at their next meeting which is scheduled for March 22 nd .
Capital Needs Assessment:	The Capital Needs Assessment was presented and reviewed regarding the care and upkeep of the Islington library branch.
FY17 & FY18 Budget:	FY17 budget is on track; Tricia Perry and Amy Rands will meet with the FinCom subcommittee to preliminarily review the FY18 budget on March 1st at 7:30am
Proposal for purchase of equipment:	The board unanimously voted for additional A/V shelving and mobile reference desk; Request for the new Bibliotheca Self-Check Station with Credit Card Payment Option is on hold for further discussion with the 21st Century foundation.
21st Century Foundation:	Talks will continue regarding doing public outreach at the next 21st Century meeting in April.
Behavior Policy:	A draft was presented and reviewed for the new Behavior Policy at the library. Behavior Policy will be discussed further and will be voted on by

	the Board at a future meeting.
Approval and Acceptances and Expenditures:	Trustees voted to expend and accept funds as presented.
