## **Library Staff Reclassification-Update**

The Personnel Board met in December to initiate discussions relating to the library reclassification. As a result of that meeting, two positions have been reclassified:

- Branch Librarian (L8) reclassified to Head of Branch Library Services (L10)
- Library Bookkeeper (L6) reclassified to Library Business Administrator (L8)

The Personnel Board will meet next on Tuesday, January 10<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 pm to continue discussions and to determine if any additional adjustments should be made to the library's ATP schedule based on a more thorough review of data provided by the consultant.

**FY17 and FY18 Budget Impact of Library Reclassification** – Discussions continue with the Personnel Board and other town officials regarding the budgetary impact of suggested modifications to specific positions and the Library ATP schedule now that the reclassification and compensation studies have been completed. Updates will be provided at the Trustees meeting on 1/9/17.
