Cost estimates for a ten-foot vinyl banner were \$50-\$150. Committee agreed upon a basic design reading “Pedestrian & Bicycle Safety Committee”, with symbols of a walker and a cyclist displayed at end each end of the banner. \$100 budgeted for the project. George to follow up with the companies to get final cost and decision to pick a vendor.
