TM report: what should we include? GC info; recycling upgrades, and trash talk; 3rd annual Recycle Day in May; Westwood Day, 8th Annual Earth Week; Real time electric metering device at HS; Plans to install wireless electric control meter at all schools; continue to work with DPW, schools to reduce energy.

Installed real time electric use monitoring device at HS in Feb, stopped working for a time, trying to figure out cause. Will install in other schools. Can control all electric items from control panel (wireless). Hope to get into library, shut lights and other systems when not in use. \$250/month for all schools. Can save 10-25% of energy cost. Can program to turn on and off automatically, based on scheduled activities. Can be overridden by Ken. Monitor notifies Ken if anything is awry. Mass Energy Insight stopped reporting end of December.

Bldg and Energy Conference: PK learned of workshop to tune up steam boilers; 5 schools have.

Alliance for Climate Education does school assemblies. Ask Emily Parks if we could bring in to Westwood.
