# WESTWOOD HISTORICAL COMMISSION

- 1. Call to Order: The October meeting was called to order at 7:35 p.m.

- 4. Review Coburn School library display status Nancy reported that Helen Rielge, the designer gave a timeline for the project. She noted the artifact display case will be first, then outside rail display, then last the mural inside library meeting room. Nancy shared renderings with the group.
- 5. Review questions on Demolition Delay Bylaws Nancy asked commission members to review rules and regulations specifically as they relate to hardships clause and come up with any questions for Nora Loughnane, Director of Economic Development.

Nancy has been asked to speak in front of the Selectmen at their October 16th meeting to give a presentation on the history of the Blue Hart tavern and provide information on why the building should be preserved. Nancy encouraged fellow committee members to also attend the meeting.
