HOW TO INSTALL A SECOND METER?

HOMEOWNER/APPLICANT PROCEDURE

WHAT IS A SECOND METER?

- Second Meters allow separate water measurement for OUTDOOR WATER USE ONLY.
- •The homeowner will submit Second Meter readings twice a year; July & October for credit
- Any water consumption through the Second Meter will be subtracted from your actual water usage. The credit will reflect on the September and December sewer bills.

WHO
INSTALLS MY
METER?

•Contact a Licensed Plumber for installation estimate/pricing.

@ BUILDING DEPARTMENT

- A Licensed Plumber must apply for 2 PERMITS:
- Application Second Meter Program (FEE: \$30.00)
- •Plumbing Permit (FEE: \$40.00)

@ SEWER DEPARTMENT

- A Licensed Plumber must give a copy of the following to the Sewer Department:
 - Application for Second Meter Program
 - Plumbing Permit
- •Plumber will obtain the Rules and Regulations of the Second Meter to give to the homeowner/applicant.
- •Homeowner/applicant must return a signed copy to the Sewer Department.

PURCHASING MY METER

- •The homeowner/applicant will purchase a Second Meter at any plumbing store that the Licensed Plumber will install.
- •Meter Minimum size: 5/8" with 3/4" connections.
- •Meter Must Read in 100 CUBIC FEET.
- •The Second Water Meter will remain property of the homeowner/applicant.
- Customers with automated outdoor sprinkler system connected to the DWWD water supply must install and maintain a RAIN SHUT OFF DEVICE (SENSOR) for their system.

AFTER INSTALLATION

- After installation, the homeowner/applicant must schedule with the **Sewer Department**:
 - Plumbing Inspection
 - Seal and Tag of the Meter
- •Once the meter passes inspection and is sealed and tagged, the meter is registered and active in the system.
