### Call to Order: 7:00 p.m.

The Planning Board will attend and participate in the Finance and Warrant Commission's public hearing, specifically to participate in the discussion of the Planning Board sponsored warrant articles for Annual Town Meeting. The last article to be presented to the Finance and Warrant Commission is relative to the vehicle parking and storage accessory uses in residential zones. The article related to medical uses was withdrawn in its entirety by a vote of the Planning Board on March 19, 2019.

Article: **Zoning Amendments Related to Medical Uses** – To see if the Town will vote to approve certain amendments to the Westwood Zoning Bylaw related to various medical uses. ***-This article has been withdrawn by the Planning Board and will not be presented.***

Article: **Zoning Amendment to Accessory Uses in Residential Districts** - To see if the Town will vote to amend Section 4.3.3[Accessory Uses in Residential Districts] to amend the requirements for private garage and the parking and storage of more than three motor vehicles in Section 4.3.3.2, or take any action in relation thereto.
