

Absentee Voting Guidelines:

You may only vote by absentee ballot if you:

- Will be absent from the town on Election day, and /or
- Have a physical disability that prevents your voting at the polling place, and/
- Cannot vote at the polls due to religious beliefs.

If you wish to vote by absentee ballot for more than one Election in a year, you may complete one application and request that ballots for all Elections during the calendar year be sent to you.

Although the deadline to apply for absentee ballots is *noon the day before the election*, we highly recommend submitting the application as soon as possible.

You may not vote by absentee ballot without first submitting an application. Once your application is received, the ballot will be mailed to you. You may mail or hand-deliver your absentee ballot to the Clerks office. It must arrive before the close of polls(8PM) on Election Day(March 3, 2020).

If you wish to cast your ballot in the clerk's office before Election Day, you may complete your application and cast your vote in one visit.

Absentee ballots are currently available in the Town Clerks office.
