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Today, the Westwood Board of Health received notification from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health that a Westwood resident has received a presumptive positive diagnosis for COVID-19.

Due to privacy issues, the Westwood Board of Health is not permitted to disclose any information about the individual with the presumptive positive test result.

The Board of Health and DPH is currently in contact with the individual. A list of close contacts is being generated and those individuals who meet DPH's definition of High Risk or Medium Risk will be contacted by the Westwood Board of Health or DPH and informed of their need to self-quarantine. If you do not receive a call, you are not considered High Risk or Medium Risk and do not need to self-quarantine.
