- 4:00 PM Call to Order
- Vote to declare a local public health emergency in response to the Governor's declaration of a State of Emergency.
- Vote to Authorize the Health Director to take necessary actions to limit community spread of COVID-19 in Westwood.
- The local public health emergency shall remain in effect until such time as the Governor's State of Emergency declaration expires or the Board of Health determines that a Local Public Health Emergency no longer exists in Westwood.
- The qualifying emergency in this matter is the declaration of a State of Emergency in the Commonwealth by the Governor in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and the Board's need to take immediate action to combat community spread.

NOTE: Per changes to Open Meeting Law, effective July 1, 2010, notice of any meeting of public body shall include "A listing of topics that the chair reasonably anticipates will be discussed at the meeting". Topics must give enough specificity so

that the public understands what will be discussed, but not necessarily all items that may come up. Please list those topics above.
