Essential Services Update:

The State announced significant updates to previous guidelines for COVID-19 Essential Services that are allowed under Governor Baker's state of emergency order. This information is important for Westwood businesses as it specifically clarifies questions related to brick-and-mortar operations, ecommerce, and curbside pick-up.
