The Board shall hear an application filed by Todd Sullivan for a Special Permit pursuant to the Westwood Zoning Bylaw Section §4.3.3.2 [Accessory Uses – Storage of Motor Vehicles] to construct a garage that would result in storage of four (4) or more motor vehicles on the property. Property is in the Single Residential E (SRE) District.
