Islington Branch

Work is continuing on the Wentworth Hall Project in Islington. Tower Library - Update: Construction is the successful bidder for the GC contract. Site work has begun and a current member of the Public Library staff has been taking photos of the various stages of the Islington Branch Library that will eventually be part of the time capsule which will be placed in the new

Wentworth Hall/Islington Branch Library.

21St Century Fund Update:

Trustee Masi-Phelps reported that new board member, Brian Mulvey has started. The Fund is doing well and will be sending out its annual fundraiser initiative in the near future. The Poet Laureate position was discussed and supported by the 21st Century Fund.
