Pursuant to Chapter 40A, §9, the Board of Appeals will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday, February 24, 2021 at 7:00 PM**. The public hearing will be a remote meeting through Zoom due to the COVID-19 state of emergency and in compliance with the Governor's March 12, 2020 Executive Order suspending certain provisions of the Open Meeting Law MGL C. 30A, §18 and the Governor's March 23 Emergency Order imposing limitations on the number of people that may gather in one place. The Board shall hear an application filed by Daniel Green of Westwood Green LLC to amend a special permit previously granted by the Board on February 28, 2020 pursuant to the Westwood Zoning Bylaw Section §4.1.7.4 [Other Uses; Temporary]. The existing special permit allows the temporary use of a single family home in a new residential development to be utilized as a design studio and sales office for a period of time not to exceed one year. The application proposes to extend the temporary use by an additional year. The property is located in the SRC (Single Residence C) zoning district.

Any zoning relief that may be required in adherence to the Westwood Zoning Bylaw shall be considered by the Board.
