Westwood Voters, please review the following protocols that will be in place for our Annual Town Election to ensure the safety of Voters and staff during this current pandemic

We have four Polling locations in Westwood that will be open from 7:00AM-8:00PM. By maintaining our normal election hours this will give voters a chance to vote throughout the day at their convenience.

Polling locations as follows:

Pct. 1-Council on Aging-60 Nahatan Street

Pct. 2-Sheehan School-549 Pond Street

Pct. 3-Hanlon School, 790 Gay Street

Pct. 4-Downey School, 250 Downey Street

If you are unsure of where you vote please click here

- Please be aware that only voters will be allowed to go into the polling place.
- If you require any special accommodations please inform the Police officer on duty or an Election
 official.
- Social distancing will be enforced; voter(s) shall maintain a six (6) foot distance from one another that will be clearly marked, both inside and outside.
- · Your precinct may look different due to a separate entrance and exit which will be clearly marked.
- Only five voters will be allowed in each precinct at one time.
- Please wear a facial covering to protect staff and other voters. We are taking this very seriously and highly encourage all voters to do their part and be considerate of others.
- If you do not have a facial covering, one will be provided.
- Disposable gloves that will be provided to you along upon request as well as a pen to mark your ballot.
- Voters will check- in with an Election officer who will be in sitting in front of a plastic sneeze guard shield wearing a facial mask. You will be required to give your name and address in a loud voice so the election officer can hear you.
- Only five voters will be allowed in the polling place at one time.
- There will be five (5) Voting booths set up with a distance of six (6) feet between them and outfitted with a germ protection guard.
- When you have completed filling out your ballot you will be ready to cast your ballot in the Image Cast Vote Tabulator.
- Voting booths and pens will be sanitized after each use by our PPE staff.
- You will now exit the polling location, depositing the pen used to mark your ballot in a designated basket, the used mask and gloves in a designated Trash Barrel, and hand sanitizer available when exiting.
- You have now completed your civic duty. The Election team, Town Clerk, Town Administrator and Board of Health Director appreciates your cooperation in following the guidelines that have been set to ensure a safe voting day for all.
