The Commission shall hear an application filed by Chris Cooney requesting permission to demolish a single family residence, which may be historically and/or architecturally significant. The structure is located at 99 Willow Street. The Historical Commission's review will be conducted pursuant to Westwood General Bylaw Chapter 250A.

The property is located in the Single Residence C (SRC) zoning district and shown on the Assessor's Map as Map 29, Lot 32. The single-family residence located at 99 Willow Street is believed to have been constructed in 1936.
