| In all grades, students learn to observe, ask questions and define problems; use the skills and tools of scientists & engineers to plan and conduct investigations/solve problems; and communicate solutions and explanations.<br><b>* Focus areas for students in grade 2 are listed below:</b><br>Understands that different kinds of plants and animals live in different environments and areas.<br>Understands how wind and water can change the shape of land, and how people can prevent or slow down those changes by doing things like planting trees and building fences.<br>Explores how materials like wood and stone look, feel, and act differently.<br>Understands the concept of friction: what happens when objects rub against one another. | In grade 2 students learn to represent an object from different sides/perspectives using basic shapes; explore the use of symbols/signs to communicate feelings & ideas; create artwork to tell a story; and share a personal reaction to artwork.<br><b>* Focus areas for assessment in all grades are listed below:</b><br>Engages positively in art class activities.<br>Accepts risks and challenges as a creator.<br>Create: Generate ideas, develop work, and refine craft.<br>Respond: Observe, reflect and interpret meaning in artistic works.<br>Connect: Connect with other artists through process, techniques, stories, and ideas |      |      |
