The Board of Assessors will be going into Executive Session to approve executive session minutes from the July 12, 2021 meeting and to review FY22 real estate abatement applications. The Board of Assessors may convene in Executive Session under Purpose 7 "to comply with, or act under the authority of, any general law, citing G.L. c.59, § 60 as the statute requiring confidentiality." See G.L. c.30A, § 21(a)(7)

Pursuant to G.L. c.30A §22(f) (g) to comply with any general law for review of Executive Session Minutes, all of which would have a detrimental effect on the position of the governing body if discussion were in open session. The Board will not be returning to open session.

NOTE: Per changes to Open Meeting Law, effective July 1, 2010, notice of any meeting of public body shall include "A listing of topics that the chair reasonably anticipates will be discussed at the meeting". Topics must give enough specificity so that the public understands what will be discussed, but not necessarily all items that may come up. Please list those topics above.
