WESTWOOD BOARD OF APPEALS

Pursuant to Chapter 40A, §9, the Board of Appeals will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday, April 27, 2022, at 7:00 PM**. The public hearing will be a remote meeting through Zoom due to the COVID-19 state of emergency and in compliance with the Governor’s March 12, 2020, Executive Order suspending certain provisions of the Open Meeting Law MGL C. 30A, §18 and extended on June 16, 2021 to April 1, 2022, and further extended on February 15, 2022 to July 15, 2022. The Board shall hear an application filed by Jayme Huber for a Special Permit pursuant to the Westwood Zoning Bylaw Sections § 4.5.3.2.2 [Alterations of Nonconforming Structures – Vertical Extension]. The application proposes to construct a dormer addition that increases the height of the building in the setback. The existing front setback is 20’where 40’ is required. The proposed height of the building addition is 19’7”. The property is located in the Single Residential C (SRC) zoning district.

Any zoning relief that may be required in adherence to the Westwood Zoning Bylaw shall be considered by the Board.

Should any person or party desire for any written material, including legal arguments or positions, to be considered by the Zoning Board of Appeals in connection with any petition before the Board, such material shall be submitted to the clerk of the Board no later than five (5) calendar days before the public hearing on the petition, or such material shall not be considered.
