

**TOWN OF WESTWOOD  
LEGAL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
WESTWOOD BOARD OF APPEALS**

Pursuant to Chapter 40A, §9, the Board of Appeals will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday, July 20, 2022, at 7:00 PM** in the Champagne Meeting Room, Carby Municipal Building, 50 Carby Street, Westwood, Massachusetts 02090. Should the Governor or State Legislature extend the Executive Order suspending certain provisions of the Open Meeting Law MGL C. 30A, §18 allowing for remote meeting participation which is set to expire July 15, 2022, the hearing will then be held remotely through Zoom. The Town website will be updated to notify those wishing to participate and a Zoom link will be provided.

The Board shall hear an application filed by Gina Szigety for a Special Permit pursuant to the Westwood Zoning Bylaw Sections §4.3.3.2 [Accessory Uses – Motor Vehicle Storage]. The application proposes to construct a one story detached two car garage. An existing two car garage is attached to the single-family residence on the property. The proposed new two car garage would create a parking or storage area of more than three (3) motor vehicles on the property. The property is located in the SRC (Single Residential C) zoning district.

Land affected: 101 Alder Road  
Map 40, Lot 067

Any zoning relief that may be required in adherence to the Westwood Zoning Bylaw shall be considered by the Board.

**Should any person or party desire for any written material, including legal arguments or positions, to be considered by the Zoning Board of Appeals in connection with any petition before the Board, such material shall be submitted to the clerk of the Board no later than five (5) calendar days before the public hearing on the petition, or such material shall not be considered.**
