- NEW Traffic / Speed Counts completed on 10/25/22 & 10/26/22 on Forbes Road 550' north of Glandore Road & 100' south of Kiloran Road
- New Intersection Counts concurrently completed at:
 - Forbes / Everett
 - Forbes / Canton
 - Everett / Canton
- Compared to 2021 Study:
 - 2021 ADT = 760 860 VPD
 - 2022 ADT = 700 770 VPD

Recommendations



- TEC provides no specific recommendation for modifications to Forbes Road to change the current status of residential versus cut-through traffic along the roadway.
 - Reasonable expectation of modest traffic on 'public way'.
 - Percentage of cut-through traffic HIGH; however, cut-through traffic volume is LOW (less than 1 cut-through vehicle per minute).
 - The overall roadway volumes is significantly less than the capacity of a local roadway (1,000 VPD).
- The 85th percentile speed along Forbes Road is slightly lower than statutory speed of 30 mph. TEC does not believe that MassDOT would consider a Special Speed Regulation less than the 30 mph already noted on the roadway by statutory law.
- Some other traffic calming measures to consider:
 - Application of the centerline through the length of Forbes Road.
 - Introduction of an additional speed hump(s).
 - Continue selective police enforcement along and the surrounding neighborhood at varying intervals.
 - Continue enforcement of the turning restrictions in place at the MS Walker Driveway to reduce the number of cut-through vehicles accessing this private development.
