

SEASONAL LABORER

Westwood Department of Public Works

The Department of Public Works has several openings for Seasonal Laborers during the upcoming summer months. This is a great opportunity to assist a busy Westwood Public Works Team with maintaining and safeguarding the Town's infrastructure. The position will perform routine laboring duties, alone or as part of a crew, as well as other related work. This is a 40-hour per week position, however, qualified candidates with part-time availability will be considered. The position requires a work commitment from mid-June through approximately the end of August.

Responsibilities and duties include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Assists with all DPW construction and maintenance projects, such as repairing and patching street and sidewalks, rebuilding catch basins, cutting grass, raking leaves, trimming brush and trees, and collecting refuse along highways.
- Operates light dump trucks and pickup trucks; hauls gravel, dirt, sand and other materials; loads and unloads materials.
- Operates jackhammer, small roller, roadside mower and performs manual labor incidental to the work of operating assigned equipment.
- Performs similar or related duties as required or as situation dictates.

Qualifications and experience: High School education or equivalent preferred. Two years' experience in Public Works construction and maintenance activities, or any equivalent combination of education and experience. Ability to perform heavy manual labor under varying weather conditions. Massachusetts motor vehicle license required.

Schedule requirements: Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. from mid-June through late August.

Salary and Benefits: This is a seasonal, non-benefit position with a starting hourly rate of \$16.50.
