The Board shall hear an application filed by Domenick Rossi for a Special Permit pursuant to the Westwood Zoning Bylaw Sections §4.5.3.3 [Special Permit required for New or Expansion of Nonconformity]. The Petitioner proposes to remove an existing deck and construct a larger deck attached to a single-family residence at 21.2' from the rear lot line, where 30' is required. The existing deck is nonconforming and violates the rear setback at 26'. The existing nonconforming structure violates front, side and rear setbacks. The lot is nonconforming as it is lacking in area and frontage. The property is located in the Single Residence C (SRC) zoning.

Any zoning relief that may be required in adherence to the Westwood Zoning Bylaw shall be considered by the Board.
