

LEGAL NOTICE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The WESTWOOD HISTORICAL COMMISSION will hold a public hearing on *Monday, July 17, 2017 at 7:30 PM* at the Fisher School at 830 High Street, Westwood, Massachusetts 02090, regarding a request by the applicant WB Realty Trust, to reconsider and modify the 6 month Demolition Delay Period decision previously imposed on the application to demolish a single family residence and barn located at 46 Washington Street, Westwood, MA. The decision was originally recorded with the Town Clerk on May 22, 2017. The Historical Commission's review will be conducted pursuant to Westwood General Bylaw Chapter 250A.

The property is located in the General Residence zoning district and shown on the Assessor's Map as Map 16, Lot 051. The single-family residence and barn are located at 46 Washington Street, are believed to have been constructed in 1900.
