The Board shall hear an application filed by Caroline Donahue for a Special Permit pursuant to the Westwood Zoning Bylaw Sections §4.5.3.2.2 [Alterations of Nonconforming Structures-Vertical Extension]. The Petitioner proposes to construct a second story addition to an existing single-family residence. The addition increases the height of the building in the front and side setbacks. The existing structure is nonconforming as it violates both side setbacks. The structure is located 13.5' from the left-side lot line and 12' to the right-side lot line, where 15' is required. The lot is also nonconforming due to lack of frontage and area. The property is located in the Single Residence D (SRD) zoning district.

Any zoning relief that may be required in adherence to the Westwood Zoning Bylaw shall be considered by the Board.

Should any person or party desire for any written material, including legal arguments or positions, to be considered by the Zoning Board of Appeals in connection with any petition before the Board, such material shall be submitted to the clerk of the Board no later than five (5) calendar days before the public hearing on the petition, or such material shall not be considered.
