Sutton to apply for a grant to fund a Universal Access Audit. It was awarded in December 2022 and a study began in 2023 and the results of the study are under Select Board review.

Conservation, Disability Commission, Public Works		X				Beginning in 2021, town officials and the CoD reviewed the School Street Playground and identified areas of concern that were impeding universal access. In the summer of 2022, C. Coleman, D. Sutton, and R. Adams and the CoD co-chairs worked together to redesign the School Street Playground to incorporate universal design. This project was funded by Norfolk County with American Rescue Plan Funds. The playground construction was completed by the Recreation Department in June 2023. The playground now has two accessible parking spaces, poured-in-place rubber accessways, safe latches on gates, and three accessible play structures: a seesaw, we-go-swing, and a wheelchair-accessible merry-go-round.	
								In 2021, the CoD met with town and school officials to participate in the design planning of the Pine Hill School. The design ensured that students with disabilities could participate seamlessly and fully in school and in after-school programs and activities. The playground was also addressed for universal design at the new elementary school. 2024 – Pine Hill School built and opened.
