Pursuant to Chapter 40A, § 10, the WESTWOOD BOARD OF APPEALS will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, April 18, 2012 at 7:00PM in the Champagne Meeting Room 2012 to Street Municipal Office Building, 50 Carby Street, Westwood, Massachusetts 02090, to consider an application filed by Thomas Viti, Library Director on behalf of the Westwood Public Library for variances from Section 5.2 of the Westwood Zoning Bylaw, entitled Table of Dimensional CLERK Requirements (§5.2.3) and Section 6.1.12 entitled Special Provisions in Residential Districts in order to proceed with the construction of an additional parking area for the new library. Any zoning relief that may be required in adherence to the Westwood Zoning Bylaw shall be considered by the Board.
