Pursuant to Chapter 40A, §9, the Board of Appeals will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday, July 18, 2018 at 7:00 PM** in the Champagne Meeting Room, Carby Street Municipal Office Building, 50 Carby Street, Westwood, Massachusetts 02090, regarding an application filed by Lawrence PetitFrere pursuant to the Section 4.5.3.2.2 [Special Permit Alterations of Nonconforming Structures, Vertical Extension] and Section 4.5.3.3 [Variance Required for New or Expansion of Nonconformity] of the Westwood Zoning Bylaw. The application is a request for a Special Permit and Variance, respectively, to construct a second floor addition with attic to the existing single family home on the subject property. The property is located in the Single Residential C (SRC) Zoning District.

Any zoning relief that may be required in adherence to the Westwood Zoning Bylaw shall be considered by the Board.

**Should any person or party desire for any written material, including legal arguments or positions, to be considered by the Zoning Board of Appeals in connection with any petition before the Board, such material shall be submitted to the clerk of the Board no later than five (5) calendar days before the public hearing on the petition, or such material shall not be considered.**
