PURPOSE:

The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become acquainted with the proposed I-95 southbound off-ramp at University Avenue interchange and Blue Hill Drive project. All views and comments made at the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

PROPOSAL:

The proposed project consists of the following elements: reconstruction of the I-95 southbound off-ramp to University Avenue; widening of the I-95 southbound mainline to provide an auxiliary lane between the adjacent rest area and the new off-ramp; termination of Blue Hill Drive in a cul-de-sac just northwest of the current off-ramp terminus and reconstruction of the University Avenue intersection including traffic signal modifications. Bicycle accommodations consisting of usable shoulders have been provided on University Avenue in accordance with applicable design guides.

A secure right-of-way is necessary for this project. Acquisitions in fee and permanent or temporary easements may be required. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts is responsible for acquiring all needed rights in private or public lands. MassDOT's policy concerning land acquisitions will be discussed at this hearing.

Written views received by MassDOT subsequent to the date of this notice and up to five (5) days prior to the date of the hearing shall be displayed for public inspection and copying at the time and date listed above. Plans will be on display one-half hour before the hearing begins, with an engineer in attendance to answer questions regarding this project. A project handout will be made available on the MassDOT website listed below.
