Dear Members of the Commission:

On behalf of the Dedham-Westwood Water District, Tighe & Bond respectfully submits nine copies of this Request for Determination of Applicability (RDA) for the proposed Well Redevelopment and Cleaning Project at 154 University Avenue, 46 Dartmouth Avenue, 346A University Avenue, 34 Yale Street, and 200 Dover Road in Westwood, Massachusetts. The proposed activities will include the application of a chemical to neutralize water within the wells followed by purging and recharging to redevelop the wells.

This RDA is being filed since the wells subject to the proposed work are located within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands (BVW). The 100-foot Buffer Zone is regulated under the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (WPA, M.G.L. c. 131 §40) and the Town of Westwood Wetland Bylaw and its implementing regulations. The proposed work will be within exisiting wells at the above referenced locations with no anticipated impacts to the surrounding resource areas. Tighe & Bond respectfully requests that the Westwood Conservation Commission make the following Negative Determination- B(2): "The work described in the Request is within an area subject to protection under the Act, but will not remove, fill, dredge or alter that area. Therefore, said work does not require the filing of a Notice of Intent."

The following text discusses the wetland resource areas, proposed activities, and proposed protective measures.

Wetland Resource Areas

Tighe & Bond has conducted a desktop evaluation of wetland resource areas surrounding the well locations with MassGIS and available Westwood GIS datalayers. The DWWD has confirmed with the Conservation Agent Karen Skinner Catrone that the use of such datalayers is sufficient for the purpose of this filing, and that field delineation will not be required. Upon a review of available GIS datalayers, Tighe & Bond has identified the following resource areas at the well locations:

• **Bordering Vegetated Wetlands**: An area of BVW occurs to the east of the wells located off of University Avenue, Yale Street, and Dartmouth Avenue. This wetland is identified as a Palustrine Forested Wetland (PFO) with pockets of Palustrine Scrub

Shrub (PSS) and borders on the Neponset River. A second area of BVW surrounds the well site off of Dover Road and is associated with Rock Meadow Brook. This wetland is best characterized as a PFO along the periphery with expanses of PEM at the interior.

- Riverfront Area: The wells located off of Dover Road fall within the 200-foot Riverfront Area to Rock Meadow Brook, while a portion of the wells near University Avenue fall within the Riverfront Area to the Neponset River. Rock Meadow Brook and the Neponset River are depicted as perennial streams on the USGS Quadrangle for Westwood and are afforded a 200-foot Riverfront Area, in accordance with 310 CMR 10.58(2).
- **Bordering Land Subject to Flooding**: According to FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Mapping (Panel No. 25021C0176E, effective July 17, 2012), the wells off of Dover Road fall within the 100-year flood zone with a base flood elevation of 190 feet. As such, this site is regulated Bordering Land Subject to Flooding (BLSF), as defined at 310 CMR 10.57(2)(a).

Rare Species

The Massachusetts Natural Heritage and Endangered Species Program (NHESP) Atlas (14th Edition; August 1, 2017) and MassGIS online (August 2017) were consulted during the preparation of this RDA. According to these sources, the proposed work areas do not fall within *Priority Habitats of Rare Species or Estimated Habitats of Rare Wildlife* (Figure 2).

Proposed Activities

The proposed work entails the redevelopment and cleaning of five wells owned and operated by the Dedham-Westwood Water District, and are located in Westwood, Massachusetts. Please refer to Figure 4 in Attachment B for further details on well locations and wetland resource area details.

The proposed maintenance work entails the application of a chemical to the wells in order to neutralize the water. Water is then purged from the well into a stilling basin and allowed to recharge to redevelop the well. Stilling basins will be lined with geotextile fabric and will be reinforced with a haybale perimeter. Water will be allowed to settle within the basin before dissipating overland and infiltrating at the site. The stilling basins will be located as far away as practicable from resource areas and will be located within existing maintained areas surrounding the wells to the maximum extent possible. The proposed work is temporary in nature, and will not result in any adverse impacts to wetland resource areas. The proposed work will not change the general characteristics of the area, as the wells are existing. Stilling basin materials will be removed from the site following well cleaning and redevelopment. The proposed well cleaning and redevelopment serves a public benefit and will improve the reliability of the water supply wells by restoring the wells to their original functionality and production levels.

Protective Measures

The water purged from the well will be discharged directly into stilling basins to allow sediment and fines extracted from the well screens to settle out within the confined basin. The clean water will then be allowed to dissipate overland and infiltrate on site. The basin will be lined with geotextile fabric and surrounded by haybales to contain any sediment

yielded from the well purging. No untreated purged water will be allowed to discharge directly into the surrounding wetlands or their buffer zones.

Conclusion

We look forward to having this opportunity to discuss this project with the Westwood Conservation Commission at the public hearing on March 14, 2018. We anticipate these materials are sufficient for the Commission to issue a Negative Determination confirming that "The work described in the Request is within an area subject to protection under the Act, but will not remove, fill, dredge or alter that area. Therefore, said work does not require the filing of a Notice of Intent." 
Community Public Water Supply - Groundwater
