NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING April 23, 2019 University Station – Master Development Plan Assessor's Map 33, Lot 013

The Westwood Planning Board will hold a public hearing on *Tuesday, April 23, 2019 at 7:00 PM* in the Downey School Cafeteria at 250 Downey Street, Westwood, Massachusetts 02090, regarding an application filed by University Station Phase 2 LLC d/b/a New England Development for a Special Permit pursuant to Sections 9.7.12.14 and 10.3 of the Westwood Zoning Bylaw for the purposed changes to affect approximately 11.4 acres located along the southern and eastern sides of Station Drive, shown within Development Area A on the Modified Master Development Plan, including modifications to the configuration of two office buildings, parking area, and open space.

The subject property is known as Development Area A of the Modified Master Development Plan for University Station, Westwood, MA 02090 also known as Assessor's Map 33, Lot 013. The property is in the UAMUD (University Avenue Mixed Use Overlay) zoning district. The subject property is presently undeveloped land on Station Drive behind the portion of University Station development that contains Target and Wegmans.
