The Westwood Planning Board will hold a public meeting on *Tuesday, May 9, 2017 at 7:00 PM* in the Champagne Meeting Room at 50 Carby Street, Westwood, Massachusetts 02090, regarding an application filed by Brigham and Women's Hospital, Inc. in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Planning Board for University Avenue Mixed Use District for a Project Development Review application, pursuant to Section 9.7 of the Westwood Zoning Bylaw for property located on the east side of University Avenue known as Development Area B in Westwood, MA 02090.
