 - a. Planning Board Determination that Core Development Area Conforms with Master Development Plan
 - b. Occurs Either Before or Soon After Town Meeting
 - 3. Later Phases of MDP Project Require Planning Board Project Development Review:
 - a. Conformance with Master Development Plan
 - b. Impact Review no impacts not accounted for in the MDP
 - c. Design Review complies with performance and design standards
 - 4. PB has Authority to Condition Project Development Review Approval
 - 5. Minor Modification of MDP Minor Changes to MDP Can be Approved Administratively by Planning Board
 - 6. Major Changes to MDP Require:
 - a. Special Permit, or
 - b. Town Meeting Action
- C. Proposed Allowed and Special Permit Uses
 - 1. Principal Uses Allowed By-Right
 - a. Banks and pharmacies with drive through
 - b. Coffee shop with drive through
 - c. Fast order restaurant
 - d. Restaurant [with or without entertainment?]
 - e. Medical center or clinic
 - f. Assisted living/memory care
 - g. Single family residential
 - h. Parking garage as principal use
 - 2. Principal Uses Requiring a Special Permit From the Planning Board
 - a. Specialized motor vehicle salesroom limited to 5,000 sf of showroom space

- b. Pet product and care facility including grooming and training
- c. Self-storage or mini-storage facility
- d. Commercial indoor recreation uses
- e. Movie theaters, music venues, bowling alley and other entertainment uses

3. Accessory Uses Allowed by Right

- a. Outdoor display, storage, sales and seating in connection with restaurant uses.
- b. ATM
- c. Accessory mobile auto audio sales, service and installation
- d. Medical Center or Clinic in connection with a principal retail use (e.g., CVS minute clinic)
- e. Pet grooming and boarding provided in connection with a retail use

4. Accessory Uses Allowed by Special Permit

a. Accessory automotive tire, battery and accessories sales and service and installation, provided that no general repair of autos shall be permitted
