• <u>Purpose</u> – Minimize the total volume of Project-generated vehicular traffic and reduce the number of single-occupant vehicles traveling to/from the Project

• TDM Measures

o Infrastructure

- Designated Parking Spaces for car/vanpool participants
- Bicycle Racks installed at convenient locations to encourage bicycle travel
- Sidewalks and Promenades to connect Project to University Ave and beyond
- Lighting to encourage pedestrian travel within Project and along University Ave
- Ramps, Crosswalks, and Traffic Signals to encourage barrier-free access
- Wide Driveways and Circulation Roadways to accommodate bicycle travel
- Multi-Use Pathway constructed parallel to University Ave

Incentives and Programs

- Join Neponset Valley Transportation Management Association (NVTMA)
 - Ride matching services to assist formation of carpools and vanpools
 - Guaranteed ride home program
- Encourage Flexible Work Hours to reduce peak hour vehicle trips
- *Coordinate with MassRIDES* to utilize NuRides Program with benefits for employees who walk, bicycle, carpool, or use public transportation
- Major Employers Designate Transportation Coordinator to promote TDM
- Participate in MBTA Corporate Pass Program to promote mass transit
- Offer Guaranteed Ride Home to all employees using alternative transportation
- Provide On-Site Sale of Charlie Cards for employees and hotel guests
