

Project Status Report

Blue Hill Drive and University Ave. Intersection

Description: MassDOT administered design and construction project. Major items of work include

- Construction of new off-ramp from Rte. 95S
- Upgrade of existing traffic signal system at University Ave. and Blue Hill Drive with a new system.
- Installation of new traffic signal system at University Ave. and the MBTA parking garage/Office Building new driveway.
- Dedicated right turn lane from the ramp onto University Ave. southbound
- Two dedicated left turn lanes from University Ave. northbound onto Blue Hill Drive, one through lane
- Two dedicated through, one shared through and right, one dedicated left turn lane from I-95N off ramp
- “dead-ending” of Blue Hill Drive with a cul-de-sac providing Whitewood Drive access to Blue Hill Drive

Project is being designed by MassDOT’s design engineer Tetra Tech. MassDOT will be responsible for the public bidding, construction and inspection phases.

Status:

- Public hearing held February 27th at Westwood Public Library.
- Expected Summer/Fall Construction
- Development agreement requires that off-ramp and capacity of intersection completed prior to opening of Retail portion of project.
- Sound wall along off-ramp will be constructed by the developer separately
